The Grand Rapids Children's Museum is seeking:

- 8-10 pairs of child-sized work boots
- 15 child-sized or small orange safety vests (closed side only please)
- 15 child-sized cotton work gloves
- 10 child-sized safety eye goggles
- 5 child-sized hard hats with front light
- Small hand shovels (plastic only please)
- Small buckets
- Children's books about construction (hard cover picture books or books for children ages 0-10, new or gently used)
- 10 flash lights (no batteries please)
- 12 child-sized leather tool belts
- Renderings with blue prints
- 1 large orange safety barrel
- Batteries for barrel lights (6 volt)
- 4 traffic cones
- Toy dump trucks, bull dozers, etc. (about 12" or more in size)
- 12 toy measuring tapes
- Construction signs/traffic control signs (i.e. road work ahead, construction zone, flag person, preferably picture signs, large about 48" - large fabric ones would be best)
- Stop/slow paddle plastic hand held sign
- 6 safety head band ear muffs
- Child-sized durable broom
- Black metal lunch pails
- Paint brushes (new)
- Paint rollers, frames and trays (new)
